NWGA Rules and Regulations

Norbeck Women's Golf Association (NWGA) membership dues are \$90 for the entire season. These dues entitle you to participate in Ladies' Days, as well as the Member-Guest Event [additional fee], the Ringer Competition, Invitationals, and Trophy Tournaments. Each member of the NWGA is responsible for knowing and abiding by all rules written by the World Handicap System (WHS) (see p 10).

NOTE: Some Norbeck Country Club membership levels have golf restrictions. Please check with the Pro Shop directly on your eligibility if you are not a full golf member of the club.

Registration and Communication

To join the NWGA, members must complete the online registration form. Dues can be paid by credit card or check and must be paid in full in order to participate. A member roster will be maintained and first published at the start of the season with period updates posted to the Norbeck site during the season.

The main method of communication is through Google Groups. All members will be added to the NWGA group to receive regular communications about upcoming events and tournaments.

Ladies' Days

Tuesdays are "Ladies' Day" at Norbeck. However, for each Ladies' Day, weekend play is available for those unable to play on Tuesday. Weekend play will be available on Saturday or Sunday before the designated Tuesday Ladies' Day.

Members must sign up in Golf Genius or in the Pro Shop by the Thursday before the weekend and the Sunday before the Tuesday Ladies' Day so that the Pro Shop can prepare the appropriate scorecards. On Tuesday Ladies' Days (but not tournaments), an optional \$1.00 fee will be collected for chip-ins.

To sign up for Ladies' Day weekend play in Golf Genius, there is a Check box for weekend play. Make your own foursomes for Tuesday individual events and the Pro Shop will make pairings for team events. Some designated weekends will have organized tee times and the Pro Shop will make pairings for team events.

Ladies' Day formats are a mix of individual and team events. For team events, the Pro Shop will do the pairings for both Tuesdays and weekends. If a foursome is not complete, a blind draw will be provided.

For all Ladies' Days, at least two NWGA members must play together to attest the scores. Except for team competition, you may sign up individually or in twosomes or foursomes; you may also call the golf Pro Shop if you need someone to play with. The Ladies' Day Chairperson determines the format for the day. Unless otherwise stated, all putts must be holed out; that is, into the cup. Immediately following their round, players must turn in attested scorecards to the Pro Shop. The number of points awarded to the winners will include the total field from weekend play and Tuesday; points will be awarded to 25 percent of the field. Winners will be announced after the Ladies' Day event on Tuesday afternoon, and members will be notified via e-mail announcement.

Points awarded to winners on Ladies' Days will be converted to club credit at the end of the season that can be used towards cart fees, dining and pro shop credit. Points are awarded as follows:

1st place	5 points
2nd place	4 points
3rd place	3 points
4th place	2 points
5th place	1 point

9-Holers

This group will play on all regular Tuesday Ladies' Days. 9-Holers will tee off at 10 am and follow similar fun formats that the 18-hole members play on that given Tuesday. Note: you must be a full NWGA member to play in this group.

Twilight Niners

In addition to our regular 9-Hole Group, we also have another 9-hole group called "The Twilight Niners." This group is open to Norbeck CC full and Associate golf members who join. **You do not need a handicap to join this group.**

The Twilight Niners will play two evenings per month, April through October, weather permitting. The group starts at 6:00 pm; later in the season, they start at 5:30 pm. You may play as much or as little as your schedule allows.

This group only plays scrambles to make it a relaxed and fun golf evening for all participants. Another benefit is that if you are not familiar with the rules of competitive golf, you can learn as you play along with mentors who will be placed in your group.

In addition to the Thursday evening play, the Twilight Niners are eligible to play in the NWGA Opening Day Scramble, NWGA Member Guest (which has its own extra charge. Note: you must have an established handicap), NWGA charity tournaments, and the NWGA closing day scramble. The fee to join “The Twilight Niners” is \$60 for the season (cart fee is not included). If at any time during the season you want to become a full NWGA member, you can do so for an additional \$30.

Any full NWGA members may sign up to play with The Twilight Niners. However, they are not eligible to win a prize if they are in the winning group.

Ringer Competition

The Ringer Competition is a fun way to see how you improve on each hole throughout the golf season, as well as to compete with other NWGA members for the lowest gross and net scores at the end of the season.

To enter the Ringer Competition, the first day of the season that you play, ensure that a Norbeck member attests/signs your scorecard, and email a photo of your scorecard to Ringersandbirdies@gmail.com, (ensure that your name, date played and attester’s name are legible!). Each time you play a round at Norbeck thereafter, email your scorecards to the Gmail address or leave your score card in the basket for collection. You can request that a copy of your scorecard history be emailed to you at the beginning of each month, which will help you learn more about your Norbeck game and how you are playing the course. At the

end of the season, Pro Shop credit will be awarded to the low gross and net winners, the number of winners depending on the total participation. **Note: The Ringer Competition begins on April 12th and ends October 20th.**

Birdie Competition

Whenever you have a birdie while playing at Norbeck, circle it on your scorecard, and email a photo of your scorecard to Ringersandbirdies@gmail.com, (ensure that your name, date played and attester's name are legible!). Soon after, your name will appear on the Birdie Tree in the Ladies locker room. At the end of the NWGA season, the member with the most birdies is declared winner and receives Pro Shop credit.

"2" Club

Several years ago, NWGA began participating in a national club called "2" Club. If you are playing with a member of the "2" Club and you score a "2" on a hole, you are eligible to join. You would purchase a "2" Club pin for \$4 from Karen Henderson (which you should display on your bag or visor, etc., so that it is visible to other members). When a member scores a "2", other "2" Club members in your group each pays a \$1.00 to that person.

Goodwill

Goodwill denotes friendliness or helpfulness. It can wish someone well, be a message of sympathy, or congratulate for an accomplishment, such as a baby, grandbaby, or wedding. If you know anyone who might need a card for any of these or other situations, please contact the Goodwill committee person (*see p 2*).

Golf Dress Regulations

Norbeck requires members and their guests of all ages to subscribe to a dress code that is in keeping with the tradition of a private country club at all times on the golf course and practice areas.

Traditional golf wear is permitted, including golf skirts, slacks, Bermuda shorts (no higher than 3–4 inches above the knee), and collared shirts (shirts without collars may be worn only if they have sleeves and were specifically designed for golf). **Not permitted** are denim of any kind, tennis shorts or tennis-length skirts, running/athletic shorts, cut-offs, sweat clothes, t-shirts, tank tops, sweatshirts, and warm-up suits. If you are in doubt concerning your attire, please check with the golf shop.

Slow Play

A round of golf is meant to be played at a prompt pace. You must not unreasonably delay play, either when playing a hole or between two holes. The official time for foursomes to play 18 holes at Norbeck is 4 hours and 5 minutes.

Players are expected to adhere to that time. If a group should lose a hole to the group in front, they must wave the following players through.

Weather Closing

If golf is canceled or if it rains on a designated Ladies' Day, there is no rain date. In case of inclement weather, please call the Norbeck Golf Course Hot Line on the morning of any Ladies' Day for information about the course (301-774-7704).

Scorecards

Only scorecards that are legible, dated, signed and attested will be accepted. All scores must be posted using the World Handicap System . All 9- and 18-hole rounds must be posted the day of play. 9-hole rounds will no longer wait for another 9-hole round to create an 18-hole score. If you play between 10 and 17 holes, you must post hole-by-hole.

Ladies' Day scores will be posted by the Pro Shop. If you play Ladies' Day on the weekend, you are responsible to post after your round.

World Handicap System (WHS) for Posting Scores

WORLD HANDICAP SYSTEM



To play in most events at Norbeck, you must establish a World Handicap System (WHS) handicap. WHS is the unified, global ruleset for calculating handicaps established worldwide in 2021. Visit www.whs.com to find out more.

It only takes 54 holes – any combination of 9 and 18-hole scores – to establish a Handicap Index and be a part of the WHS. Once you've posted 54 holes, you will have an official Handicap Index.



GHIN (Golf Handicap and Information Network) is the tool to enter scores that is a specific technology platform and service provided by the USGA to calculate, store, and manage your WHS handicap. There is an annual fee of \$65 to cover registration with the USGA/GHIN service, allowing you to easily track your handicap index. Contact the Pro Shop to add the handicap fee to your member account.

Maintaining Your Handicap

- Submit scores before midnight on the day you play. Your handicap index will fluctuate based on your 8 best scores out of the past 20 scores.
- All golf rounds must be entered in the handicap system from March 15 through November 30 in Maryland.
- When you travel and play rounds of golf in the U.S. and Internationally, you follow the established GHIN season dates. For example, Florida's season is year-round, so if you play a round there, you should post your scores to your existing Maryland profile even though Maryland is "inactive" from Dec 1 – March 14. For the United States, "active" GHIN handicap seasons vary by state based on the climate. For warmer climates you enter scores year-round (e.g., FL, TX, AZ, SC, GA). For states with significantly cold winters, you enter scores between April and November. When you play internationally, ask if it is active season.
- 9-hole (plus) scores Anytime you play 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, or 17 holes enter your score for all holes. An 18-hole score differential will be calculated and added to your record.
- Net Double Bogey is the maximum score for handicap purposes. Net double bogey (Par + 2 + strokes received). However, this does not apply to tournaments (e.g. Ladies' Days) – you must "hole-out" during a tournament and enter your actual number of strokes into GHIN. In other words, you may not use "Net double Bogey" during a tournament.

The following events require a WHS handicap and GHIN posting:

- Ladies' Days
- Invitationals
- Beat the Pro
- Tournaments
- Member Guest
- Match Play: Norbeck Open
- Team Matches: WDCGA, M-PG, MD State
- Wednesday Night League
- Any other tournaments where you play your own ball throughout.

NOTE: Twilight Niners and NWGA Opening and Closing Day scramble events do not require a handicaps.

Member-Guest Event

To play in the Member-Guest event, you must have an established WHS handicap *and* be a member of the NWGA. Also, your guest(s) must have an established WHS 18-hole handicap.

Members will be allowed to bring up to three guests to the Member-Guest event. ***There must be 2 to 3 guests in a foursome; for example, 2 members/2 guests or 1 member/3 guests.*** If you sign up as a twosome, the committee will attempt to pair you with another twosome, but there is no guarantee of entry.

Tournament Rules

To be eligible for Tournament play, you must have paid the annual NWGA fee of \$90. Sign up in the Pro Shop by the deadline (*which will be announced via email for each tournament*). The Pro Shop will make pairings, which will be available in the Pro Shop on the weekend before each tournament or on the Norbeck online tee-time reservations sheet. The field will go out in ascending handicap order.

- 1. Know the Rules** – All players are responsible for knowing the rules governing each tournament. Rules will be announced before each tournament.
- 2. Changes** – Any changes in times and pairings will be made by the Pro Shop and chairperson. Please be courteous and call the Pro Shop **and** chairperson if you find that you cannot play after signing up.

3. Time of Starting – The player shall start at the time laid down by the Tournament Chairperson. All tournaments are played from the first tee by assigned tee times, unless otherwise specified. If a member is late to the tee, the threesome should go without her. If the player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, the penalty is loss of first hole in match play, or two strokes at the first hole in stroke play instead of disqualification. However, if the player is more than 5 minutes late, the penalty is disqualification.

4. Ties – All ties will be decided by the USGA recommendation, sudden death, 18-hole playoff, or match of cards, as designated by the Tournament Chairperson.

Note: The USGA recommended method of matching cards is to determine the best score for the last nine holes. If the tying players have the same score for the last nine, determine the winner on the basis of the last six holes, last three holes, and finally, the 18th hole.

5. Scorecards – Scorecards must be legible and filled out according to the instructions for each tournament, signed, and attested. All scores must be posted that day (*see pp 15–17 for Trophy Tournaments*).

6. Weather Closing – In the event of inclement weather, please call the Norbeck Golf Course Hot Line (301-774-7704) on the morning of the tournament for information about the course.

Tournament Weekend Play

Women who cannot play the Trophy Tournament rounds on the regular scheduled day(s) may compete in the tournaments by playing on the Saturday and/or Sunday ***before*** the regularly scheduled day.

If you choose to play on the weekend, you must sign up in Golf Genius or the Pro Shop by the deadline, designating Saturday or Sunday play in the comment box of Golf Genius.

As another option, the Pro Shop is providing a block of tee times for organized weekend play for all the scheduled monthly tournaments. This will give those unable to play on Tuesday mornings a chance to participate as a group. If interested, tee times are typically assigned in the early afternoon so that groups can socialize together after their rounds. Sign-up email reminders will be sent out before each weekend of tournament play.

For either form of weekend tournament play, you must play with an NWGA member, and your card must be properly signed, dated, and turned into the Pro Shop immediately after play.

The tournaments that are eligible for weekend play are:

- Grandmother's/GrandOther's Tournament: Saturday and Sunday
- Flag Day: Saturday and Sunday
- Firecracker Open
- Dogwood Better Ball: Saturday, Sunday, Tuesday and Friday
- Two-Lady Team

Weekend play does not apply to the Ladies' Club Championship, which has its own schedule for play (*see p 17*).

Note: Slow play rules will be enforced. Two rounds on the same day are prohibited.

2026 Tournament Formats and Dates

*To participate in an 18-hole tournament at Norbeck, players must have established scores for a minimum of 54 holes—any combination of 18-hole and nine-hole scores will suffice. This policy includes both 9-holers and 18-holers. Please check tournament dates, formats, and trophy information carefully for each tournament (*see pp 16–18*).*

Net and gross trophies (or Pro Shop credit) will be awarded to 25% of the field (rounded up), e.g., 20 players, 5 winners; 27 players, 7 winners. Tournaments will not be flighted, except for the Ladies' Club Championship (*see p 18*).

Similar to Ladies' Day, points will be awarded as follows: First place 5, 2nd place 4, 3rd place 3, 4th place 2 and 5th place 1. The dollar amount of the points will be determined at the end of the season.

Pairings and times will be assigned on the basis of handicap, lowest tees off first, and play will be in foursomes from the first tee. Ties will be broken by the USGA recommendation for ties. Call the pro shop for your tee time or check the Norbeck tee reservation online.

To enter a Trophy Tournament, sign up in the Pro Shop **by the deadline announced** for each tournament. *Note: IF late entries are accepted, players will be placed at the end of the field, regardless of handicap.*

Trophy Tournaments

Grandmother's Tournament: May 19 – An 18-hole individual net stroke play tournament played with 95% handicap. Net prizes (one gross) are awarded to 25% of the field. You must be a grandmother to participate (non-biological grandmothers are included). First tee time is 8:30 am.

Entries close 4:00 pm, Thursday, May 14.

GrandOther's Tournament: May 19 – An 18-hole individual net stroke play tournament played with 95% handicap. Net prizes (one gross) are awarded to 25% of the field. Any NWGA member who does not qualify to play the Grandmother's tournament is eligible to play in this tournament. Tee times will be assigned following the Grandmother's tee times.

Entries close 4:00 pm, Thursday, May 14.

Flag Day: June 23 – An 18-hole individual net stroke play tournament using 95% handicap. Prizes are awarded to 25% of the field. The first time is 8:30 am.

Entries close 4:00 pm, Thursday, June 18.

Firecracker Open: July 28 – An 18-hole two-lady team scramble tournament. Teams will receive 35% of the lower handicap team member and 15% of the higher handicap member. Net prizes (one gross) are awarded to 25% of the field. The first tee time is 8:30 am.

Entries close 4:00 pm, Thursday, July 23.

Dogwood Better Ball: August 18/August 21 – A 36-hole net ringer tournament using 95% of handicap. Net prizes (one gross) are awarded to 25% of the field. The first tee time for

both rounds is 8:30 am. Second day pairings are based on the first day low net scores.

Entries close 4:00 pm, Thursday, August 13.

If you choose to play in the two-day Dogwood Tournament, you have several two-day options. Although it will normally be played on Tuesday and Friday, you may compete on Saturday, August 15, Sunday, August 16, Tuesday, August 18 and/or Friday, August 21. When you sign up, you designate which two days you will be playing. If you have any questions concerning these rules, please contact the Tournament Chairperson before signing up. Note: you must play on the day(s) that you specified when you signed up in the golf Pro Shop.

Two-Lady Team: September 15 – The first 6 holes will be a Scramble using 80% of the lowest handicap; the second 6 holes will be a Pinehurst Scotch, using 60% of the lower handicap and 40% of the higher handicap; and the third 6 holes will be Better Ball of the twosome, using 90% of each player's handicap up to 36. The winning team will be the lowest combined scores of all 6-hole rounds. Net prizes (one gross) are awarded to 25% of the field. The first tee time is 8:30 am.

Entries close 4:00 pm, Thursday, September 10.

President's Classic: October 3 – The format of the President's Classic will be determined by the NWGA president; notification will be sent to members beforehand.

Entries close 4:00 pm, Thursday, October 1.

Tournament Dilemma (IMPORTANT!)

If you sign up to play in a two-lady event and you cancel, you not only leave your partner without a player, but you can leave the other team in your group without a player to attest their score.

If you must cancel, please make sure that no one is left in this situation. If you must drop out, ask your partner to play without you to attest scores or find another NWGA member who will fill in that group to attest scores.

If these two options are not feasible, the Pro Shop may put the twosome at the end of the field (regardless of handicap) in hopes of finding an NWGA member to play with them, but there is no guarantee. If none of these options work, the twosome without a scorer would be disqualified.

Ladies' Club Championship

The Club Championship is not an NWGA event; you do not need to be an NWGA member. It is open to *all* Norbeck ladies. The club will charge a \$35 entry fee to your account and go directly to the prize pool.

Club Championship— October 17 (Round 1), and October 18 (Round 2). A two-round stroke play tournament played in flights of up to eight players, seeded by handicap.

The Championship flight comprises entrants with the lowest handicaps and is played at scratch. Any entrant may elect to play in the championship flight if vacancies exist (e.g., if there are fewer than eight eligible players). Entrants who qualify for the championship flight based on handicap

do not have the option of playing in any flight other than the championship flight.

All other flights will play with handicaps. If there are fewer than four entrants in the last flight, the last two flights will be adjusted to allow a more equitable number. Trophies are awarded to the winner and runner-up of each flight. However, if there are only four entrants in the last flight, the trophy will be limited to first place only. Tied matches will be resolved by sudden-death playoff.

Times and pairings will be assigned by the golf Pro Shop. Play will be in foursomes unless otherwise stated. Tee times and pairings will begin on October 17 and 18. All rounds must be played on these dates and tee times assigned times by the Pro Shop.
